FEMA:

FEMA Center will handle Hurricane Sandy and the nor'easter as one storm.

FEMA strongly advises that people register in advance of visiting the disaster center.

- Logging into: www.disasterassistance.gov.
- TTY number at 800-462-7585.

Residents can apply for FEMA aid without coming to the County Center.

RECOVERY CENTER STAFFED BY REPRESENTATIVES FROM:

- **Con Edison** to answer customer questions about outages and restorations; engineers and customer representatives will be there to answer specific questions
- **FEMA** to help individuals, households apply for financial aid for losses and damages caused by the storm
- The **Small Business Administration**, which will help businesses apply for low-interest loans for storm-related damages
- A variety of **social services agencies** to provide residents with recovery assistance
- The **Department of Health** - free tetanus shots to anyone involved with cleanup (removal of debris from homes, parks, roads, treatment plant and other critical facilities); **Friday, Saturday and Sunday and at other locations.**

IMPORTANT PREPARATION:

Residents and Businesses-

(1) document losses with photographs and with receipts from repairs.

(2) must contact their insurance company to find out what – if anything – is covered.

(3) all persons applying for assistance should be prepared to provide FEMA with:

- Social Security number (including your spouse's if applicable);
- Private insurance information, if available;
- Address and zip code of the damaged property;
- Directions to the damaged home or property;
- Daytime telephone number, and
- An address where you can receive mail.
