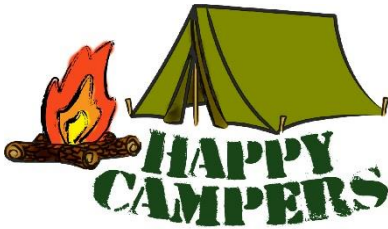

**Check in:** You must check in with Recreation staff / volunteers upon arrival, please let us know if you will be arriving late.

**Camp Sites / Tents:** Camp sites are 20' x 20'; families can request to have their camp site next to a friend (group). Need help setting up your tent? No problem... Helpers will be available to assist those in need!

**Saturday Afternoon Swim:** (*weather & staff permitting*) 4 – 6pm in designated areas of the pool based on staff availability. Sorry – no diving board use

**Activity Area:** Hosted by the Recreation & Parks Department will be set up for those looking for quiet activities: Board games, cards, coloring, etc. will be available.

**Dinner:** This is a BYOF camp out (bring your own food) -- bring dinner, drinks, snacks. Condiments will be supplied such as: ketchup, mustard, relish, salt/pepper.

**Meal suggestions**

- Pre-made sandwiches
- Pre-cooked chicken
- Salads
- BBQ items (examples... hot dogs, hamburgers) Keep food in sealed containers, coolers etc. or in your car
- You may bring your own camp stove to be used in the designated cooking area; use only the barbeque grills provided by the Town.
- Coffee and hot water for tea and hot chocolate will be available Saturday evening and early Sunday morning (milk, coffee, tea bags and hot chocolate mix will be provided).

**Dessert:** The Bedford Chowder and Marching Club will be providing ice cream from a Ben and Jerry's Truck! 7:30-8:30pm

**Water:** Will be available at the drinking fountain located at the pool bath house. For those wishing to refill larger water jugs a water faucet within the pool facility will be made available. **NO** water used for drinking is to taken from a garden hose.

**Trash and Recycling:** There will be ample trash & recycling containers throughout the camp site area. All trash & recycling will be emptied and removed at 11pm to deter over night unwanted visitors.

**Campfire:** Manned/maintained by staff and will be lit at 7:30pm and fueled until 11pm.

**Lights Out:** Quiet time starts at 11pm for all campers (we want to be good neighbors).

**Breakfast:** The Bedford Chowder and Marching Club will be providing breakfast from 7am until 9am. Bagels, cereal and juice will be available. Hot chocolate, coffee and tea will be available starting at 6:30am at the pool patio area by the pool concession stand.

**Camp Site Breakdown:** Complete by 10:30am on Sunday.

**Restrooms:** The pool bath house will be open from 3pm until 12:00am and again from 6am until 10am during the camp out. The seasonal restroom at the C&M Pavilion stand and in the rear of the bath house will be open throughout the camp out.

**Supervision:** The Bedford Recreation and Parks Department staff will provide supervision throughout the camp-out.

**Please Note:** Updated information will be posted as needed throughout the spring and summer. Families who register for the camp-out will be sent event updated by email in advance of the event.

- Drinks - Reusable water bottle/jug of water for drinking
- Bug spray
- Camp chairs
- Personal Hygiene items
- Flashlight/lantern with extra batteries
- Trash bags
